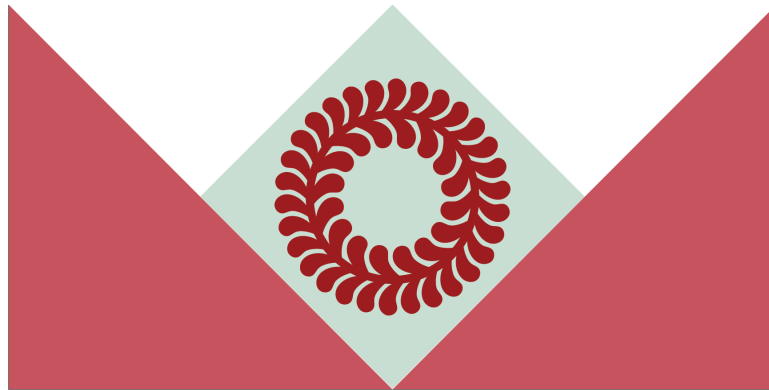

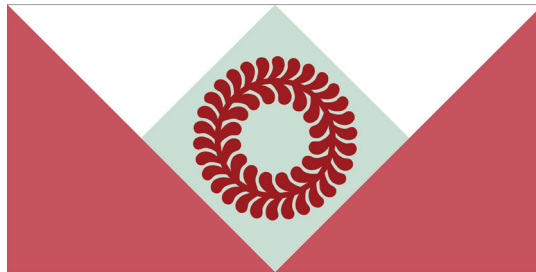

Block of the Month Flying Geese Block 2



12-in x 24-in
finished size

Cutting directions for 4 flying geese blocks:

White fabric -

(2) 13-1/4" squares cut on both diagonals for a total of 8 quarter square triangles (qst).



Red fabric -

(4) 12-7/8" squares cut once on the diagonal for a total of 8 half-square triangles (hst).



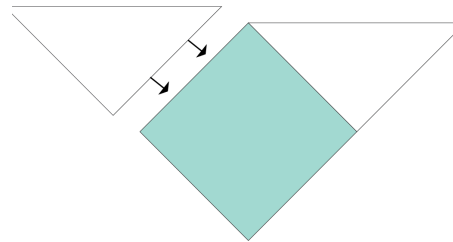
Teal fabric -

(4) - 9" squares. Cut bigger if wanted and trim down to 9" square after applique is finished.

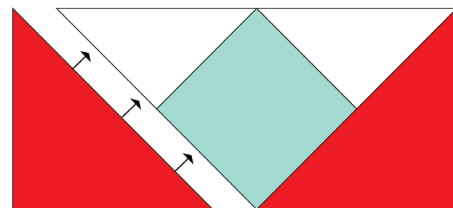
Sewing directions:

1. Complete applique on 9" teal background. If the block was cut larger than 9" before applique, trim down to size when applique is completed.

2. Sew one white qst to the upper left and one white qst to the upper right side of 9" teal background square. This makes the center triangle or "goose" of the flying geese unit.



3. Sew one red hst to each side of the "goose" for completed flying geese unit.

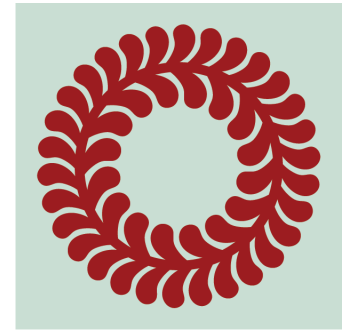

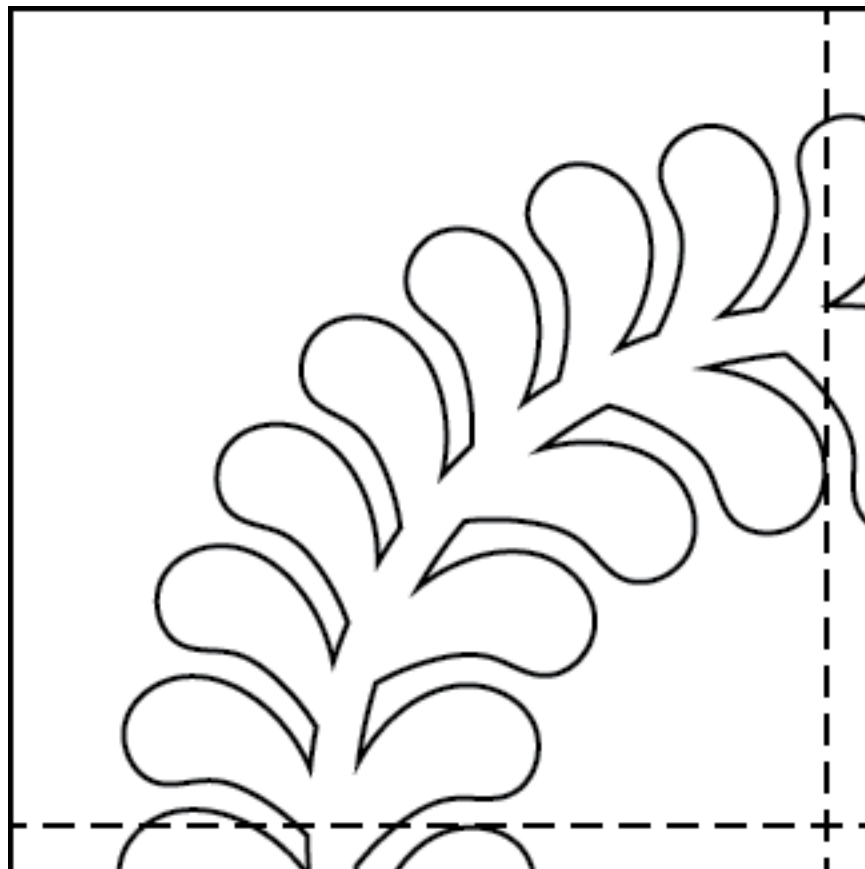
Flying Geese block 2

The teal background used for this block is cut 9" square. For completed pattern and proper placement cut and tape all 4 quadrants together



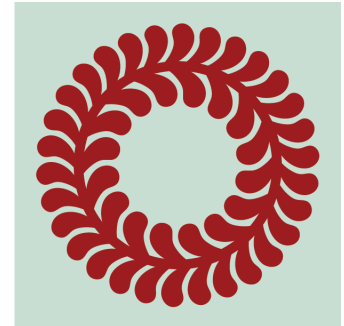
For greater accuracy, this box should measure 1"



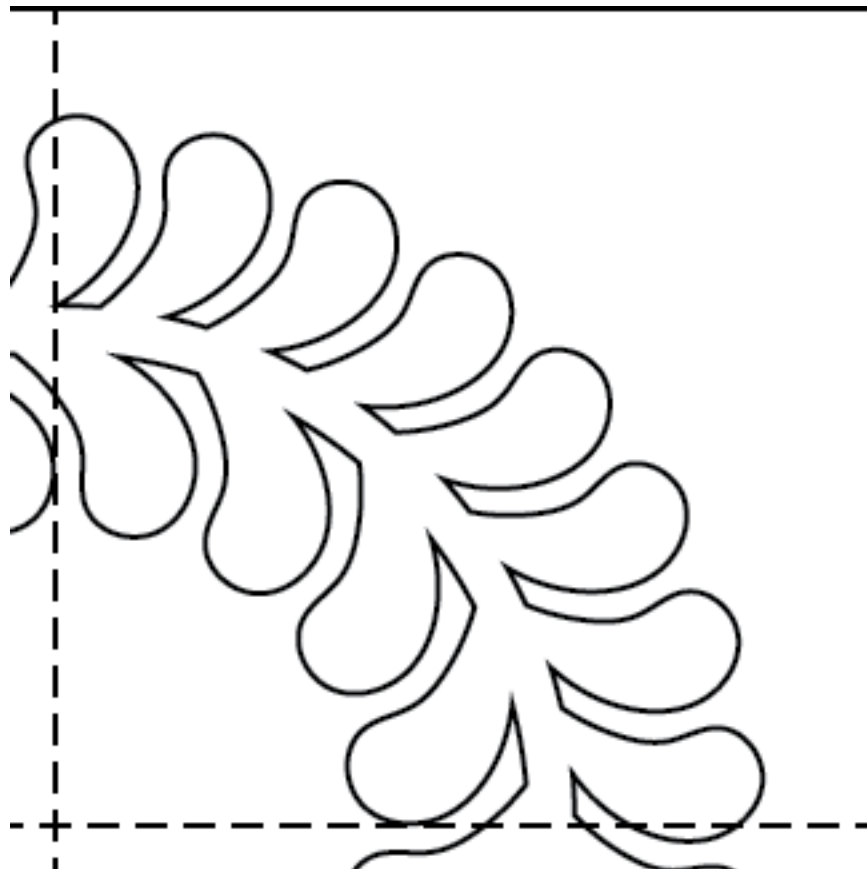

The teal background used for this block is cut 9" square. For completed pattern and proper placement cut and tape all 4 quadrants together



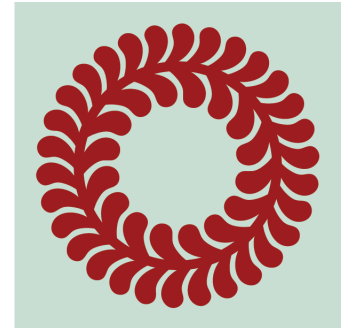

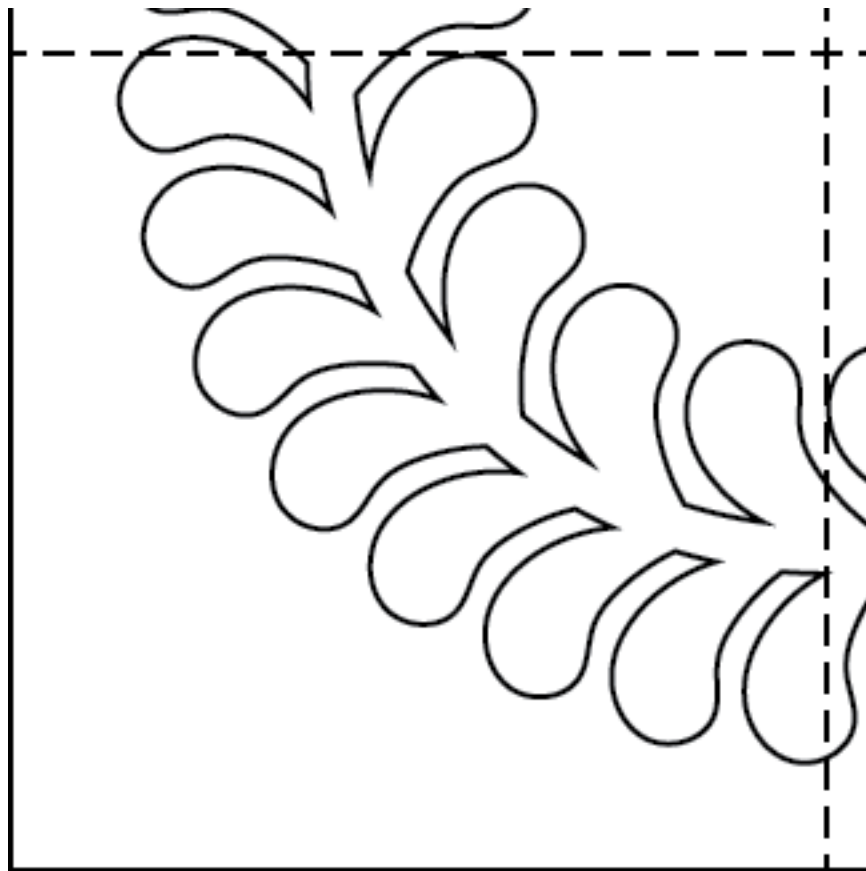

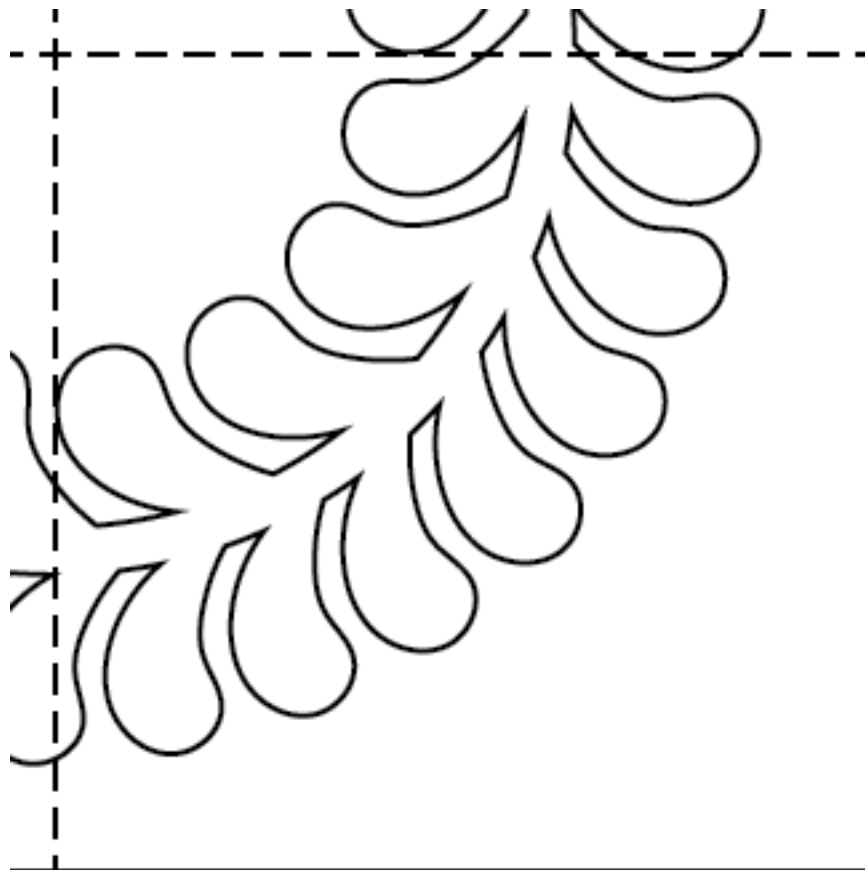
Flying Geese block 2
