

Cutting Instruction

Pink fabric – 2 ½ yards

Sashing

(20) strips cut 2" x width of fabric (*WOF*)

1st border

(4) strips cut 2 ½" x *WOF*. (Piece the strips in pairs to make the (2) 2 ½" x 66 ½" top and bottom borders and (2) 2 ½" x 70 ½" left and right borders.)

3rd border

(12) strips cut 2 ½" x *WOF*. (Piece the strips in (4) groups of three to make the (2) 2 ½" x 86" top and bottom borders and the (2) 2 ½" x 90" left and right borders)

Brown fabric – 3 ½ yards

Sashing

(40) strips cut ¾" by *WOF*

Cornerstones

(2) strips cut 2 ½" x *WOF* - subcut into (25) 2.5" squares

2nd border


(4) strips cut 8 ¼" x *WOF*. (Piece the strips in pairs to make the (2) 8 ¼" x 70 ½" top and bottom borders)

(6) strips cut 8 ¼" by *WOF*. (Piece the strips in (2) groups of three to make the (2) 8 ¼" x 86" left and right borders.)

Binding – 1 yard (based on 2 ½" wide binding)

Quilt Assembly


1. Sew 2 brown ¾" x *WOF* strips to either side of each pink 2" x *WOF* strip.



2. Subcut each strip into (2) 2 ½" x 14 ½" units for a total of 40 units.




3. Sew 4 pink/brown strips to 5 cornerstones, alternating units.




5. Repeat to make 5 strip sets.

6. Sew 5 pink/brown strips to 4 applied blocks, alternating units.




7. Repeat to make 4 strip sets.


8. Sew the strips sets together, alternating units.




9. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 66 1/2" pink strip to both the top and bottom to make the first border.




10. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 70 1/2" pink strip to both the left and right side to complete the first border.




11. Sew (1) $8\frac{1}{4}''$ x $70\frac{1}{2}''$ brown strip to the top and bottom to start the 2nd border.




12. Then, add (1) $8\frac{1}{4}''$ x $86''$ brown strip to each of the right and left sides of the quilt.



13. For the final border, add (1) $2\frac{1}{2}''$ x $86''$ pink strip to the top and bottom of the quilt.



14. Add (1) 2 ½" x 90" pink strip to both the left and right side of the quilt to complete the quilt top.



15. Layer, baste, and quilt as desired.
